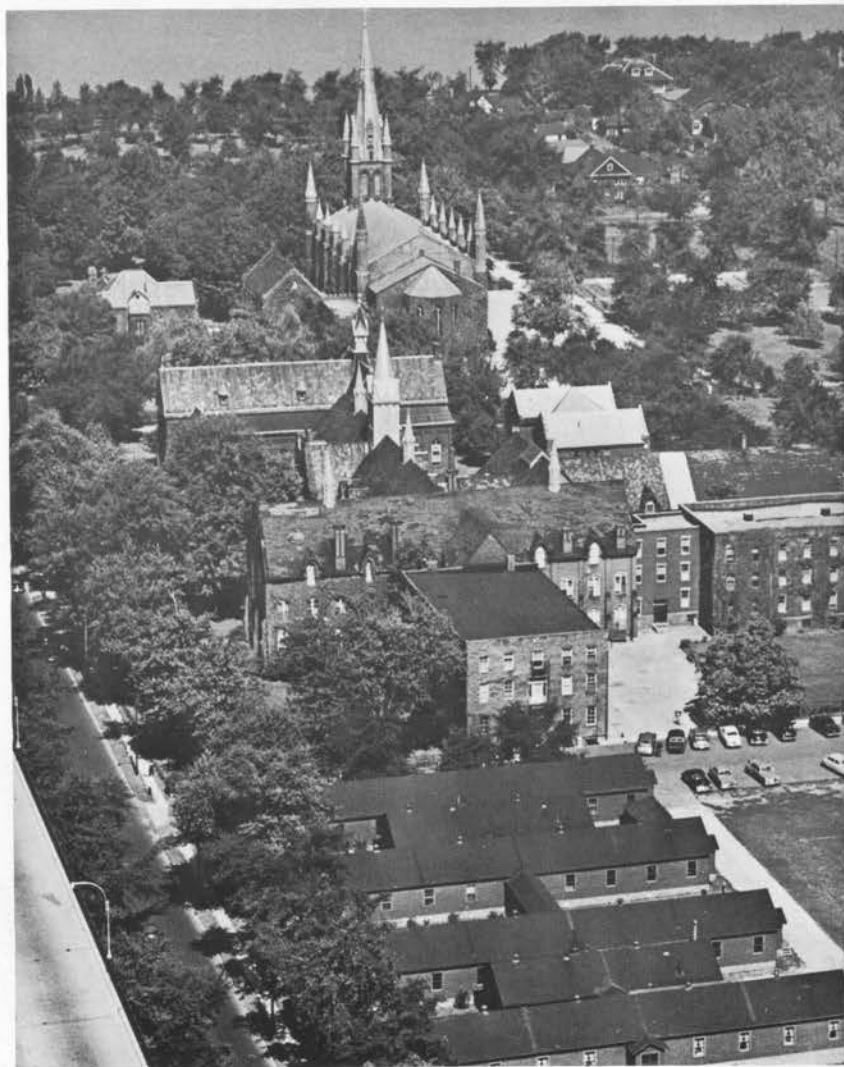

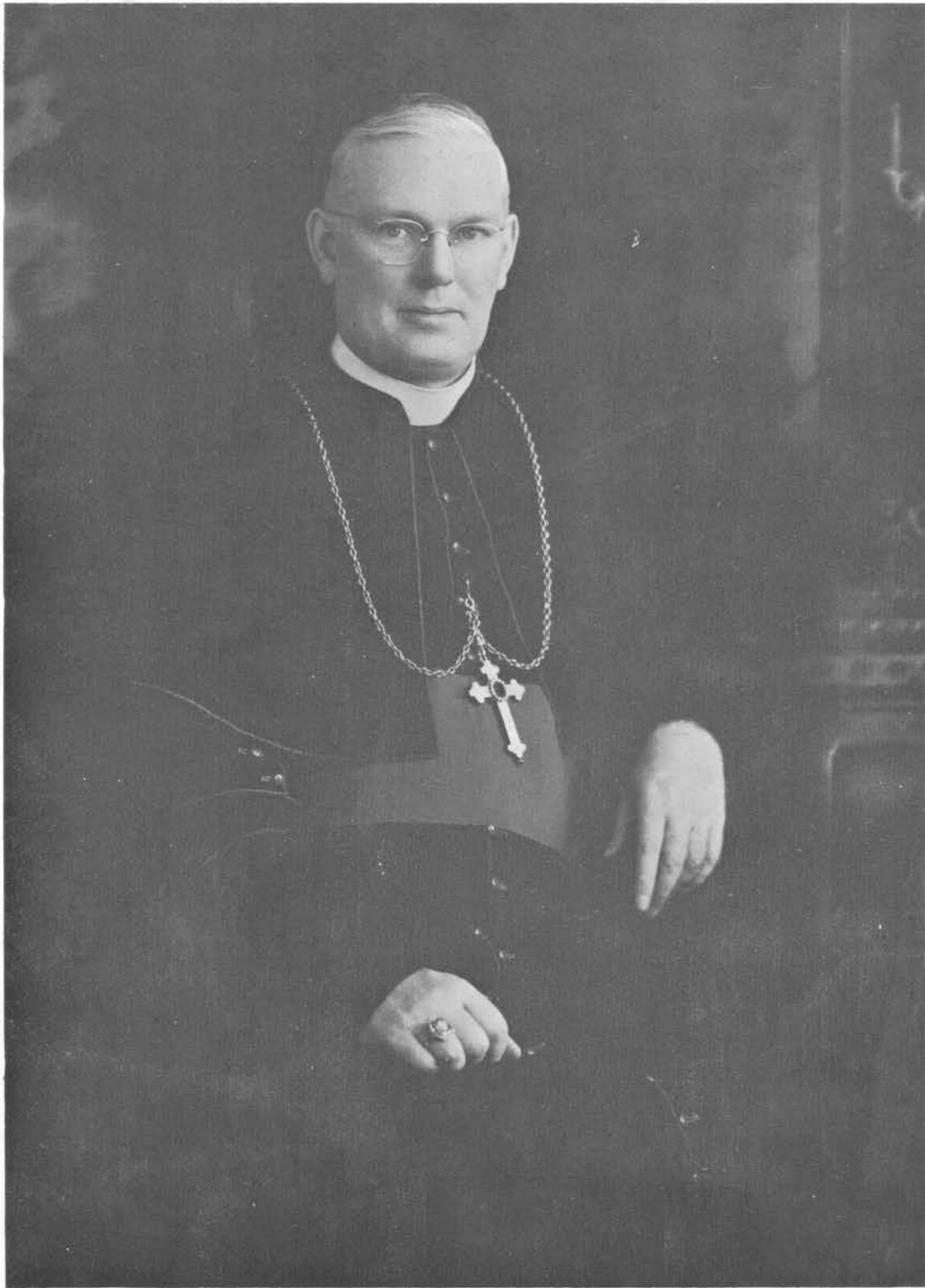

DEAR GRADUATES,

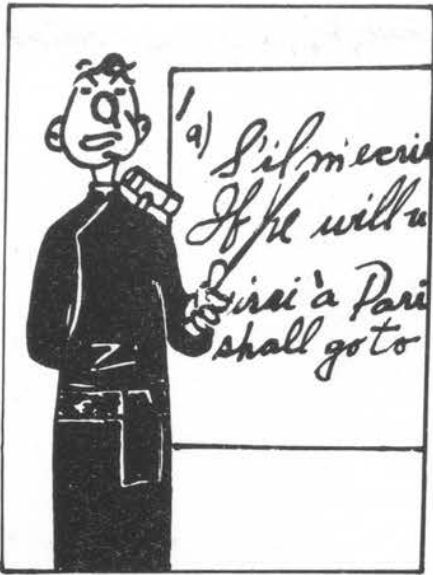

LEO GASPARET

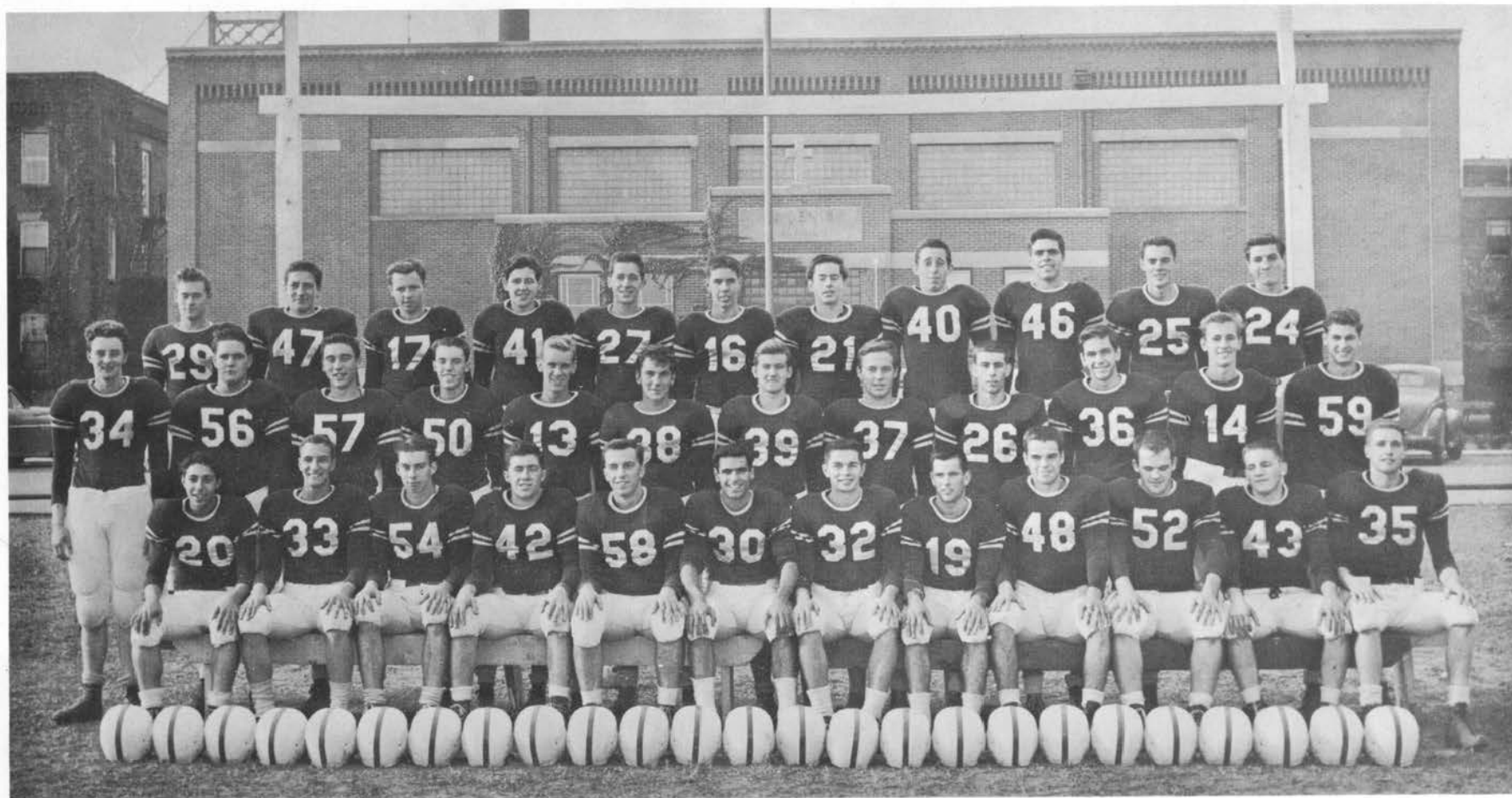

The successful season was due more to the coordinated efforts of the team as a whole, than to the work of individual stars.

Real teams reach the top only after toil, disappointments, self-sacrifice, and prayer. These four qualities made this year's City Champs great. No team worked harder than they to win; none took defeat more bitterly; all players made great sacrifices for the good of the team; each game was begun with and ended with a prayer to Our Lady of the Assumption. We hope the teams of the future can imitate in some little way the Champs of 1953.

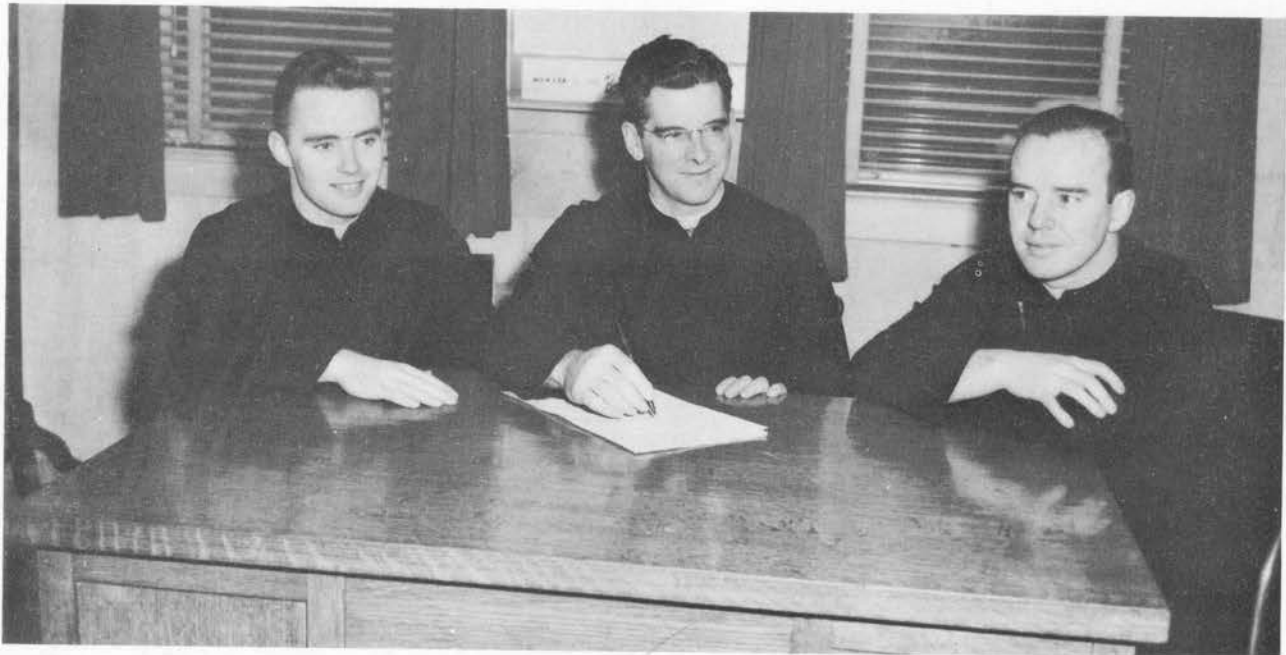

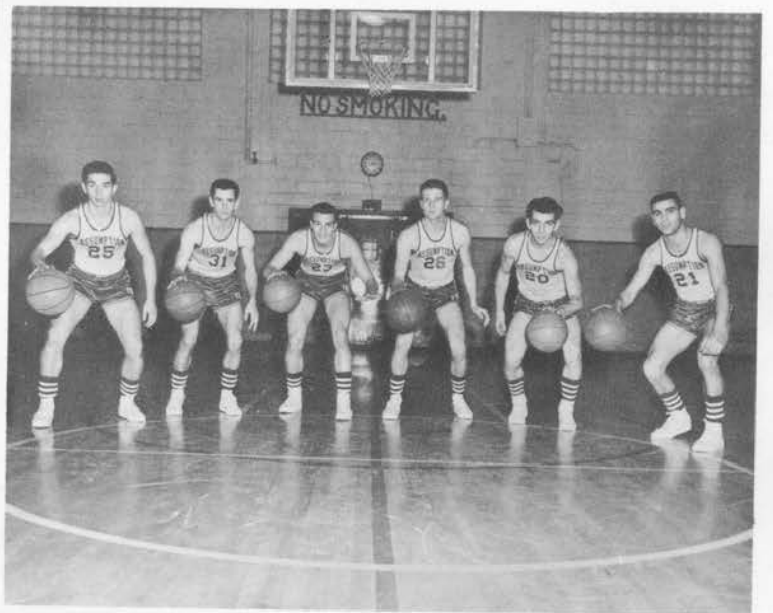

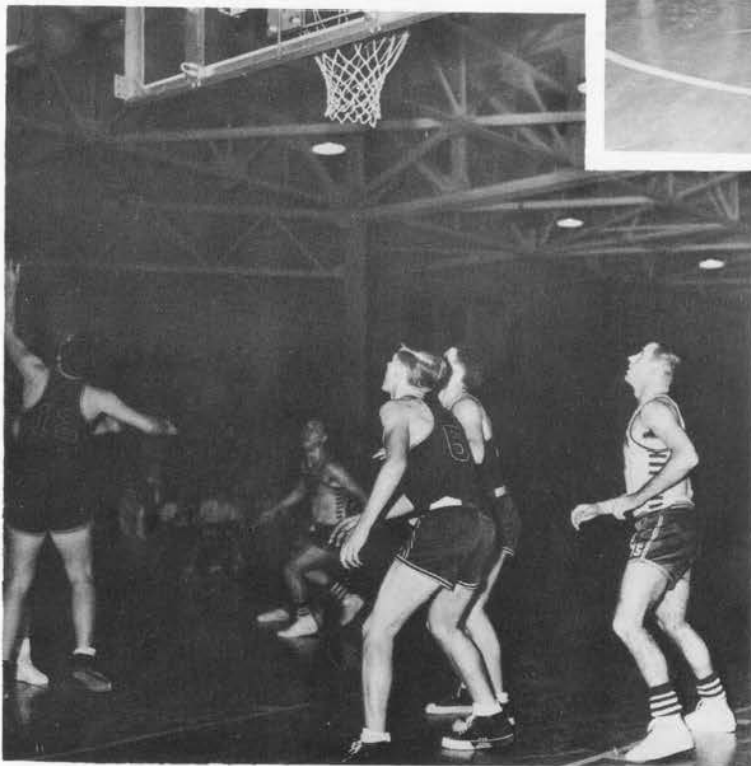


"Bertoia makes it look easy"
