# LET FREEDOM RING !!

"Justice and liberty are indivisible." "Emancipation" and "freedom" brings to mind an act or process of setting free, of liberation from a regime of class and caste imposed by force and which violates the basic, elementary rights of a segment of a nation or society; a repeal of jungle law where the strong prey on the weak and defenceless. Yet overtones of superiority based on race, creed or colour may give tacit approval to those who could callously employ devices designed and intended to keep the exploited in subjection. On the other hand a people may be emancipated from shackles yet permit their minds to remain enslaved due to fear and sustained harassment.

Nowhere on the American continent is the Negro accorded more humane treatment than he shares in Canada. It can be fairly said also that no other ethnic group is more loyal to our flag or more unaffected by insidious 'isms' alien to the Canadian way of life. Today's acceptance and tolerance in this racial instance was not always so! Canada accepted the fugitive blacks fleeing from the lash and brutality of the odious slave system, but manifestations of discrimination and segregation became immediately evident. Jim Crow schools came into being at Windsor and other points in Ontario. But today an excerpt from our national anthem, "O Canada, glorious and free!" reflects more than an abstract legal expression! Our laws are impartial, administered equitably by fearless and independent judges. Men who will tolerate no discrimination of persons or classes based on colour, race or creed. Freedom must be personified as a virile, dynamic, ever increasing sense of pride by every man, woman and child if it would remain the Gibraltar upon which our country shall survive in an era of unprecedented social revolution which is engulfing the world like a colossal tidal wave. LET FREEDOM RING!

The Negro, fleeing from the degrading ignominy of slavery sought sanctuary in Canada. He encountered prejudice and social and economic disabilities but in a lesser degree than had been his lot in the U.S.A., (the

land of the free and the home of the brave). But these slaves, our forefathers, imbued with and inspired by a faith in God, motivated and actuated with courage and with a determination to overcome, influenced the heart-strings of the good. There came an acquiescence, at times slowly, but surely, to the democratic premise that for Canada to retain status as a nation in the halls of world opinion, the Fatherhood of God and the brotherhood of man must become a reality rather than a frothy preachment. Our country implemented its ideals in practice. Human dignity assumed a new dimension — it took precedence over colour and friendship overcame hostility. The dawn of a new day broke through the mirage of ambiguity. Action replaced double talk. The buds of black hope burgeoned into full-fledged flowers. The sun shone with greater brilliance and men of goodwill said LET FREEDOM RING!

This 34th Emancipation Celebration being held in Windsor, to some may present just a mammoth parade and show — buffoonery with a Mardi gras spirit and not too subtle undertones of business and profit. But there is a deeper, more profound spirit in which thinking and proud Negroes in unanimous accord with their white brothers foresee a better world tomorrow, a world wherein it is acknowledged that there is only one race — the human race! They will view this event as a celebration of the sublime of peace on earth and goodwill towards all men. In their mind's eye they will visualize and know that from Bona Vista to Vancouver Island this land was made for you and me; bigots and racists notwithstanding. LET FREEDOM RING!

We wait with faith that day when black and white, Jew and Gentile, Catholic and Protestant, shall join handclaps and, in a loud resounding cheer say, "Free at last, free at last, than God Almighty! Every man, regardless of pigment, creed or race is free at last!"

LET FREEDOM RING, LET FREEDOM RING, clarion shrill, LET IT RING!

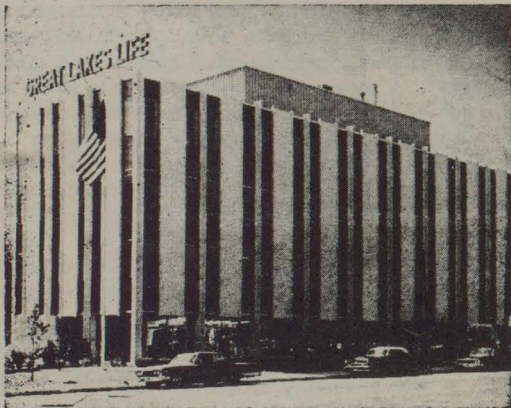

# Guest Speaker - Carl B. Stokes

State Representative Carl B. Stokes now is completing his second term with Ohio House of Representatives, is an attorney, resides at 3376 East 147th. Street, Cleveland, Ohio, with his wife the former Shirley Edwards of Columbus, Mississippi, and their two children, Carl, Jr., age 8 yrs. and Cordi, age 5 yrs.

Representative Stokes is a native Cleveland, 39 years of age, the son of Mrs. Louise Stokes and the brother of Louis Stokes, who is an attorney. He attended the Cleveland public schools and graduated from East Technical High School. He received the Bachelor of Science in Law Degree from the University of Minnesota and LLB Degree from Cleveland-Marshall Law School.

Now in the private practice of law as partner with the firm Stokes & Stokes, he formerly served for four years as Assistant Prosecutor for the City of Cleveland. Most of this service was as trial counsel.

Representative Stokes served in the United States Army from July 8, 1945 to December 23, 1946 and was honorably discharged after serving in the European Theatre.

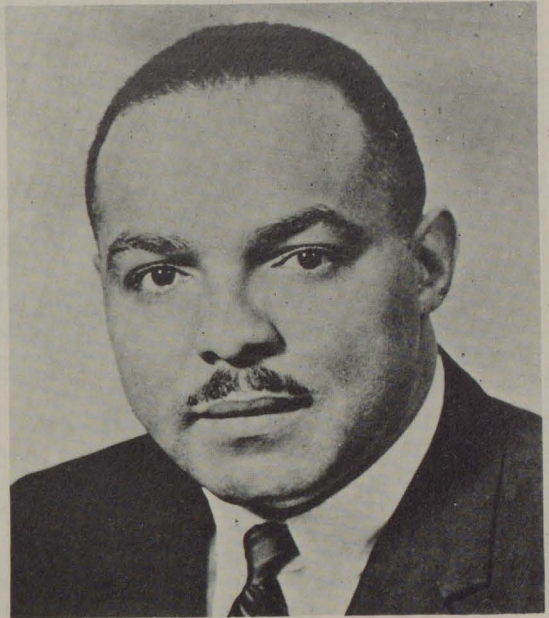

In addition, Mr. Stokes holds working memberships in the professional and fraternal organizations of: Cleveland, Cuyahoga and Ohio Bar Associations; Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity; the International Benevolent Protectorate of Elks; and the Gamma Eta Gamma Law Fraternity.

In 1962 Stokes became the only Negro Democrat ever to be elected to the Ohio Legislature. Now completing his second term, he has sponsored or co-sponsored

the following legislation: Aid to Dependent Children of Unemployed Fathers; Ohio's Ratification of the United States Constitutional amendment abolishing Poll Tax as a voting requisite; the Fair Housing Bill; strengthening of civil rights under Ohio's Search and Seizure laws; revision of the Ohio Bail Bond laws designed to curb traditional abuses; abolishment of recognition of common-law marriage; and the providing of additional state aid to urban school districts where there are appropriations of state financial aid; a "conflicts of interest" bill providing a code of ethics for members of the general assembly, its employees and state agency employees; the Rights of Prisoners bill providing immediate visitations or telephone contact by an attorney for a prisoner under arrest or restraint; the Welfare Reorganization Act, completely reorganizing Ohio's five major welfare programs and providing for state financing and county administration; the Legal Counsel for the appeal of a felony conviction of an indigent; and other legislation going to technical improvement in Ohio Law.

Stokes has been the recipient of several awards and citations for his service in civic, community and political affairs, among which, was the Cuyahoga County Young Democrats Annual Shavego Service Award as the outstanding Young Democrat of Cuyahoga County.

On November 2, 1965, running as an independent candidate for Mayor of Cleveland, Stokes lost the election by 2,143 votes out of a total 237,000 votes cast.

On May 2, 1966 re-elected to third term in Ohio House Serving on

# AN EDITORIAL . . .

Much has been said about a report published last fall indicating, among other things, that long-established patterns of social segregation have continued to separate the Negro and white communities of Windsor beyond the areas of employment and public accommodation.

But there's at least one aspect in which the contention doesn't hold a drop of water, according to Walter L. Perry, founder and director of the annual Emancipation celebration.

This is in the realm of membership in Essex County's marching bands.

"There's no place where there are as many integrated bands as in Essex County," declares Mr. Perry.

Bands please Windsor's "Mr. Emancipation" no end and when bands in the county have reached the point that Negro and white musicians march side by side in such great numbers and in so many units, Walter is particularly delighted.

Mr. Perry has gone to great lengths for 34 years to produce a parade that's an eye-catcher and a crowd-pleaser as a highlight of the yearly celebration.

When he sees integration as it exists today among Essex County's young music makers, Mr. Perry says he is able to produce evidence to partly support his belief that there's a good feeling of togetherness in many circles between Negroes and whites.

One of the purposes of Walter's Emancipation celebration, which mainly celebrates the abolition of slavery in the British Empire, is to show that "his people" are the same as others. "The only difference is that our skin is a darker colour," he said.

The bands which play a big part in the annual Emancipation parade serve as one of the best illustrations that the Negroes and whites in Essex County are united and integrated in a most harmonious manner.

The study undertaken by Dr. Rudolf Helling, head of the department of sociology and anthropology at the University of Windsor, at the request of the Ontario Human Rights Commission, has been disputed in some circles of the Negro community.

Some of the findings have been challenged quite strongly.

One wonders just who is right.

Windsor Alderman Dr. Roy Perry, brother of Walter Perry, founder and director of the annual Emancipation celebration, felt Dr. Helling's report was unfair because the sociologist did not interview the proper people in all cases.

"He spoke to people who have chips on their shoulders, to people who have no real background knowledge of the situation, and who didn't know what they said," Alderman Perry remarked.

He reeled off a list of names of Negro men who have established themselves in various commercial enterprises in Windsor over the last 25 years and said "Dr. Helling didn't interview these people."

His remarks were in answer to Dr. Helling's statement that of the 15 largest industries, nine have no Negro employees; none of the 15 companies employs a Negro in a managerial capacity and only one company employs a Negro in a professional category. Employment of Negroes is concentrated in the automotive industries and in small service type industries, the report said.

One can't argue against statistics and facts in this regard. But there is at least one point open to argument. This deals with the fact that Dr. Helling formed his opinions after questioning 97 Negroes who live in the Windsor area. When it is considered there are several thousand in the district, one is inclined to feel that talking with only 97 of them wouldn't give a true indication.

Rev. Armand J. "Benny" Jacques, a former Windsor man who has been a missionary in the Far East since 1927, will be recipient of this year's Emancipation celebration "Freedom Award."

It will be presented Sunday, July 31, at Jackson Park, following the Emancipation parade, which begins at 1:30 p.m. and which will reach the park around 3 o'clock.

Mr. Perry is arranging to have former colleagues of Fr. Jacques present for the occasion.

Fr. Jacques is spending the summer in Windsor and will return to his recently-dedicated church in Houli, Taiwan, in September.

He left for the Far East following his graduation from Maryknoll College, New York, in 1927. He was captured by the Japanese shortly after the Pearl Harbor attack, was repatriated in 1945 and returned to Manchuria.

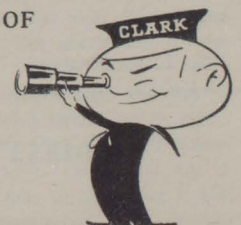

## Viet Nam Soldier

I am an American Negro in the U.S. armed forces in Viet Nam. I turned 20 years old on the 14th. of April. First thing I want you to remember is that I am definitely not a "white man lover" no matter what first impression you may get from this letter.

I was brought up in my short life a lot differently than over 99 per cent of the people who have ever been able to reach my age. That's a lot of people! Because of this background of mine I began to think our nation's racial problems at the age of 11 years from my own point of view, not my mother's. I had been under her influence on the subject until that time.

I have come to the conclusion that, as a whole, the reason that the Negro is still persecuted by the Caucasian is the Negro's own fault. I have well known facts to back up what I have just stated! If you would be so kind as to look at American history, you will note that the American Indian did not get up on soap boxes on street corners and say: "Look at me, the persecuted Indian, I want my rights." He did not march around some city mayor's home and make an undesirable spectacle out of himself. But now he is just as equal as the Caucasian. I can also point out the same thing with the American Chinese people who were not the original occupants of America just as we were not.

To make the matter worse, the white people of places like Seattle, Wash. where there used to be complete racial integration, were utterly turned against colored people during the Selma, Ala., crisis. Why? How? Simply because if the colored people wanted to demonstrate, they could have at least gone to Selma to do it. There was no racial problem in places like Seattle to demonstrate about. But no, they had to go and defeat their own purpose and ruin a good thing. They don't even realize that that's what they have done!

It is a fact that an all too large majority of Negro people belong to the categories that I have outlined, unfortunately, and more of them to the extremely just plain loud group. I am happy to say that I am a part from these types of people, no matter what his race might be. My best friend is a white man. I go around with a group of people, both white and colored, who feel exactly the way I do. I have a Negro girlfriend who I'll probably marry someday. I was not brought up on money; I've lived on my mother's relief cheques for three-quarters of my civilian life, so I didn't acquire my opinions or my friends as a result of wealth. It just came from using my head to determine plain facts. Facts that are obvious. It's just that I'm not scared of the truth.

One thing, though, just to prove that I'm not a "white man lover" you should find it interesting to know what I wrote to the editor of the Philadelphia Inquirer concerning the Girard College crisis that came up a while ago. I don't remember the date of the paper it got in or I would help you out on that score. I did not go for what was happening at all as far as barring colored people from the school goes.
