Balance of Choices Involving Chance: Psychometric Evaluation

This study is one in a series of studies that were being used in the creation of a new scale of measurement for risk perception. This specific study had the main objective of performing psychometric evaluations to determine the reliability and validity of the new scale. Preliminary analyses suggest that the new scale has internal reliability and has provided evidence toward establishing validity of the scale for assessing risk perception in some domains.
